Cookies Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. A script is a piece of program code that is used to make our website function properly and interactively. This code is executed on our server or on your device.

We use the following cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation
 of our website. These essential cookies are always enabled because our website
 won't work properly without them. They include, for example, cookies that enable
 you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of ebilling services we may offer. You can switch off these cookies in your browser
 settings but you may then not be able to access all or parts of our website.
- Statistical, Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and
 count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when
 they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example,
 by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. We may collect
 information about your computer including your IP address, operating system and
 browser type, for system administration and to report information to advertisers.
 This is statistical data only and does not identify any individual.
- Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our
 website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name
 and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region,
 to create video content, contact forms and social media functions such as 'like' and
 'share' buttons that remember your login information if you share content with your
 friends and contact).
- Targeting cookies. These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose so that they can serve you with relevant advertising on their websites. Please note that the following third parties may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These named third parties may include, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services. These third party cookies are likely to be analytical cookies or performance cookies or targeting cookies:

Consent

When you visit our website for the first time you will be shown a pop-up with information about cookies. You will be given the option to accept or deny to the use of statistical and marketing cookies.

If you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.

Further information

Login - When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for a year. If you select "Remember Me", your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

Comments - If you leave a comment on our site, you may opt-in to saving your name, email address and website in cookies. These are for your convenience so that you do not have to fill in your details again when you leave another comment. These cookies will last for one year. Visitor comments may be checked through an automated spam detection service. When visitors leave comments on the site, we collect the data shown in the comments form, and also the visitor's IP address and browser user agent tring to help spam detection. An anonymized string created from your email address (also called a hash) may be provided to the Gravatar service to see if you are using it. The Gravatar service privacy policy is available here: https://automattic.com/privacy/. After approval of your comment, your profile picture is visible to the public in the context of your comment.
